


How to create and add your ORCID iD in Pure

TU Delft Library, 2s March 2017

Your publisher may have asked for an ORCID iD when you submitted a publication or you may have already chosen to set up an ORCID profile to promote your research output. As an increasing number of publishers, research funders, and universities adopt ORCID, having your ORCID iD in Pure will maximize the opportunity for system integrations in the future.

You can check in the [ORCID registry](#) whether you already have registered an ORCID iD. If you do not have an ORCID iD yet follow the steps below to register an ORCID iD and add it to Pure. If you already have an ORCID iD you can add your ORCID iD to your Pure profile by connecting once from Pure to Orcid.org.

1. Log onto [Pure](#)
2. On your Personal overview, click on the **Edit profile** button.






3. In the new window, click on the **Create or Connect your ORCID ID** button.


